Peter has often been called the 'Prince of the Apostles' because of the words of Jesus re-naming him, from Simon to Cephas, the Aramaic form of the Greek word Peter, which means 'rock'.

Jesus said that on this rock He would build His Church. But both Peter and Paul came to be seen as having different roles to play within the leadership of the Church:

Peter in witnessing to the Lordship of Christ and Paul in developing an understanding of its meaning for Christ's followers.

Peter and Paul have been remembered jointly on this day since the very early days of the Church, it being regarded as the anniversary of their martyrdom in Rome in about the year A.D.64.
