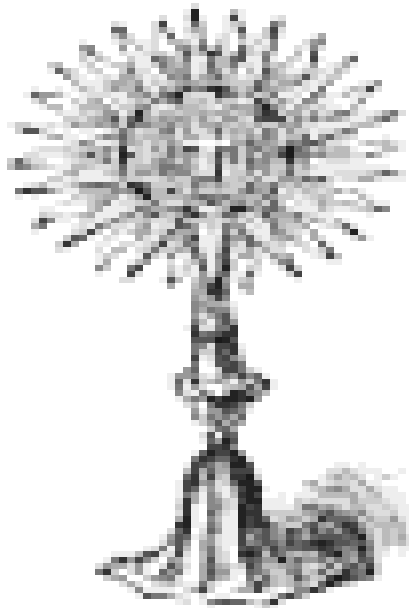
*Blessed are the peacemakers:
